47th Annual Muscogee Nation Festival Fast Pitch Softball Tournament Official Rules

Tournament Director: Brigham Bert 918.758.8214

- 1. Tournament begins at 7:00 p.m., Friday, June 23, 2023. Saturday & Sunday games begin at 9:00 a.m.
- 2. ASA/USSSA rules apply. ASA and USSSA bats are legal. No senior league bats. Umpires will check bats periodically.
- 3. All teams are required to supply their own softballs. 47/375
- 4. GAME TIME IS GAME TIME. Each game will have a time limit of 1 hour and 20 minutes. Grace period of 10 minutes for first game only. In case of rain, game time limit is one (1) hour.
- 5. Each game consists of a maximum of seven (7) innings with INTERNATIONAL TIE BREAKER IN EFFECT. No new inning with 5 minutes of remaining game time.
- 6. RUN RULE: Twelve (12) after Three (3) innings, Ten (10) after Four (4) and Eight (8) after Five (5) innings. If game applies in championship finals.
- 7. Pitcher must stay on rubber. Pitcher may push off and jump but CANNOT step on side or in front.
- 8. No practicing on the infield during tournament play.
- 9. Submit TEAM ROSTER to the registration table before the start of the team's first round game. If a player(s) name is not on the Team Roster after the game has started, the player is NOT eligible to play in the tournament. If the above mentioned player(s) have played, the game results in a team forfeit. If a player(s) name is on the Team Roster and he/she is not able to play his/her first game, then he/she may check in at their next scheduled game.
- 10. Tournament Director will post TOURNAMENT BRACKET. Coaches: please check bracket throughout the course of the tournament. Forfeit or weather conditions may cause changes in bracket.
- 11. The flip of a coin determines home team and the responsibility of official score keeping unless an official scorekeeper is available.
- 12. Protests must be made during game in which protests arise. A \$100 CASH protest fee must accompany any/all protests. All protests + fee are forwarded to the Tournament Director for ruling. Decisions are final; if the decision is in agreement with the protesting party, the Protest Fee is refunded.
- 13. UNSPORTSMANSHIP LIKE CONDUCT will NOT be tolerated; this includes profanity directed at the officials, players, fans, etc. An ejected player or coach must leave the playing area. If the player or coach does not leave, the game will result in a team forfeit.
- 14. Alcohol and/or drugs are NOT tolerated on any part(s) of the premises (this includes parking areas). Violators can and will be prosecuted.
- 15. Each team is responsible for the clean-up of their dugout area after each game.
- 16. Any questions or concerns are to be directed to the Tournament Director.
- 17. MUSCOGEE (CREEK) NATION, THE SOFTBALL COMMITTEE, TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR AND VOLUNTEERS ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LOSS, THEFT, OR INJURY TO ANY PERSON AND/OR PROPERTY.
