48th ANNUAL MUSCOGEE NATION FESTIVAL SLOW PITCH SOFTBALL TOURNAMENT OFFICIAL RULES

1. Tournament open to ALL teams.
2. ASA/USSSA rules apply. ASA and USSSA bats are legal. Banned bats are in effect. No senior league bats. Umpires will check bats periodically. **TEAMS MUST SUPPLY THEIR OWN SOFTBALLS.** Core 52/300 for men and 44/375 for women
3. Unlimited number of homeruns.
4. **ALL TEAMS MUST REGISTER BEFORE THEIR FIRST GAME.** Roster limit of fifteen (15) players per team. TEAM ROSTER MUST BE COMPLETED AND TURNED IN A MINIMUM OF 30 MINUTES BEFORE THE BEGINNING OF EACH TEAM'S FIRST GAME. The roster turned in is the official roster. All individuals that are playing must sign the roster. If you have players that cannot make the first game, be sure to list their names on the roster. These players are to check in at the registration table BEFORE they play their first game. NO ADDITIONS OR CHANGES WILL BE ALLOWED AFTER THE ROSTER IS OFFICIAL. If a person that is not listed on the official roster plays, the game could result in a forfeit. TEAM JUMPING IS NOT ALLOWED. Once a player has played their first game with a certain team, they are to play with said team for the remainder of the tournament.
5. Entry fee must be paid in full before registration.
6. Teams must be prepared to play thirty (30) minutes before the scheduled game time. The line-up must be given to the home plate umpire before each game. GAME TIME IS FORFEIT TIME.
7. The flip of a coin will determine the home team. Home team is responsible for keeping the official score unless an official score keeper is available.
8. RUN RULE: Twelve (12) run lead after the 3rd inning, ten (10) run lead after the 4th inning, and eight (8) run lead after the 5th inning.
9. TIME LIMIT: Each game will have a time limit of 55 minutes with the exception of the championship game(s). Run rule is still in effect.
10. All protests, plus the \$250 cash protest fee, will be directed to the Tournament Director for ruling. Director's decision is final. If the final decision is in agreement with the protesting party, the protest fee will be returned. PROTESTS MUST BE MADE DURING THE GAME.
11. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated; i.e. profanity directed at the officials, players, etc. An ejected player or coach must leave the playing area. If the ejected person does not leave, the game will result in a team forfeit.
12. STEEL CLEATS NOT ALLOWED. Women are allowed to play barefoot. IN COED, MEN MUST SLIDE HEAD FIRST IF WOMEN MAKE PLAY ON THEM OR RESULT IN AN OUT.
13. If the tournament is cancelled because of weather conditions, it will be rescheduled at a later date. If a game has started and play is interrupted, the game will resume where play was delayed.
14. The Muscogee Nation Festival Softball Committee, the Omniplex, and volunteers are not responsible for any loss, theft, or injury to any person.
15. DRUGS AND ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE NOT ALLOWED! ALL VEHICLES ARE SUBJECT TO SEARCH UPON PREMISES.
16. Each team will be responsible for the clean up of their dugout area after each game.
